Q1. The bid documents place the responsibility for relocating all movable items, except for large furniture, on the tenant. Will PBHA inspect to assure compliance prior to abatement contractor mobilization, or should exceptions be addressed by the contractor at an hourly rate to be included in the bid?

A1. The contract requires an initial walkthrough with property management. PBCHA will confirm resident compliance.

Q2. Please confirm whether abatement may be performed in more than one containment area at a time, allowing contents to be rotated between two work zones. We understand this method would require additional clearance testing by the project consultant and request confirmation on whether it is acceptable.

A2. Work zones are by Building.. Some buildings contain as many as 4 apartments. The work may be allowed dependent on PBCHA's ability to relocate residents.

Q3. We are preparing our bid for the asbestos Removal and Abatement Services at our Dyson properties. Our bid bond may take longer than usual because of the size and the price of the scope. Can the bid date be extended to 9/16/25 to ensure our bonding is secured?

A3. No, the date will not be extended due to the urgency and importance of the project.
